Young leads Raider victory

South Point's Red Raiders tripped the light fantastic in Fallston Friday night, bombing out the Burns Bulldogs in a big Southwestern

3-A Conference game for both teams.

Before it was over, South Point's star tailback, senior Akron Young, had continued his sensational antics, picking up 242 yards rushing in 27 carries and scoring three touchdowns as the Red Raiders waltzed to a surprisingly easy 50-13 victory after being burned at Shelby the week before 29-6.

The victory evened South Point's league record at 2-2, the same as Burns. The Red Raiders, who host R-S Central in their homecoming

game next week, are 2-3 overall. Burns is now 3-2 overall.

Young, who entered the game with 629 yards rushing in four games, now has 871 yards in five games and bids to become South Point's all-time single season rushing leader barring an injury.

South Point held a 22-7 halftime lead, then outscored Burns in the

final two periods 28-6.
